Attention AP Students - AP Exam Sign-Ups Begin February 4

AP Exam Sign-Ups will be February 4 - March 22, 2019.

Take completed form in person to Mrs. Hicklin in the counseling office before school, after school, lunch and break only - Mrs. Hicklin is not available during class time. Only one form per student is needed for all exams.

- Fee is \$100 per exam February 4 February 22
- Fee increases to \$115 from February 25 March 15
- Fee increases to \$130 from March 18 March 22

Checks should be made out to LCHS-AP Exams. Combine the cost of all tests per student on to one check if possible. Similarly, only write one check for multiple students in the same family, if possible. If paying cash, please have exact change.

Please note that absolutely no late signs ups will be taken or refunds given after March 22, 2019.

Tests will take place from May 6 through May 17.

CSF Applications Due February 13

The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) is a statewide organization that recognizes academic excellence upon graduation at the high school level. All Freshmen, Sophomore, Junior and Senior students with good grades and citizenship are encouraged to apply each semester. To attain full membership and a CSF Gold Seal, a student needs to successfully submit an application at least 4 semesters of high school. One semester must come from senior year. (Freshmen students' qualification for high school CSF does not begin until this semester, because they need four semesters of high school grades).

Now is the time to turn in the application with last semester's report card! The application is available online, beginning Monday, Jan. 14th. We are not running off applications any more to hand out. You may go to Lchsspartans.net to the student portal. On the home page, click on "Files and Forms." Under this section, click on "Academic Files and Forms." Click

on the app for CSF. For those of you with no access to a printer at home, you may use the printers in the IRC. Please turn in the application along with a copy of this last report card (from Semester 1, 2018), to verify grades and citizenship. * Do not turn in just a grade report/transcript. We need to verify citizenship. The application and report card copies are due in the main office in the CSF Tray, no later than

3:30 P.M. on Wed, February 13th. There are no service hours to complete and no dues to pay.
