Attention AP Students - AP Exam Fee Increase February 22

AP Exam Sign-Ups will be February 4 - March 22, 2019. Print and complete the AP form under "Academic Planning" and then "AP Exam Info and Ordering" under the "Counseling" tab on the school website (lchsspartans.net).

Take completed form in person to Mrs. Hicklin in the counseling office before school, after school, lunch and break only - Mrs. Hicklin is not available during class time. Only one form per student is needed for all exams.

- **Fee is \$100 per exam February 4 - February 22**
- **Fee increases to \$115 from February 25 - March 15**
- **Fee increases to \$130 from March 18 - March 22**

Checks should be made out to LCHS-AP Exams. Combine the cost of all tests per student on to one check if possible. Similarly, only write one check for multiple students in the same family, if possible. If paying cash, please have exact change.

Please note that absolutely no late signs ups will be taken or refunds given after March 22, 2019.

Tests will take place from May 6 through May 17.
