Over the course of the last several weeks we have advertised open positions in the PTSA for next year. We have had a wonderful response to our call for help. Under Ways and Means, the fund-raising arm of PTSA we are in need of volunteers who can help take on:

Value card: The PTSA sells this card as a PTSA fundraiser. The job entails contacting vendors to confirm that they wish to continue participating in the value card and reaching out to any new local businesses as space on the card becomes available. Contact the printer at the end of summer to get cards into production and mail out cards after the online orders are complete. Takes 10 to 20 flexible hours over the summer.

Under Programs, we need:

Reflections Chairs The national PTA art contest is called Reflections. Many of our students participate in the program and are recognized locally, and some advance to state and national levels. We need two individuals who are willing to take on this position and coordinate student entries.

Founders Day: We are looking for a chair to coordinate the Founders Award nomination, selection and on-site ceremony. The PTA Founders award is given to teachers, staff and parents who have gone above and beyond to help our school Nomination forms are circulated in late fall and selection made in January. The district wide reception is usually in March. **Total hours are 12 to 15 throughout the year.**

Under Membership:

New Family Social: We are looking for one or two volunteers to serve on the committee that will host welcoming new families to our District. This job is shared with the middle school. It takes place at the high school on a weekday late afternoon the week before school starts. The chair coordinates with the administration and with hospitality chairs for reception snacks. **This position requires a maximum of 10 hours of coordination.**
